



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

PERMIT NUMBER -PER10130

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

ALL REGISTERED PRODUCTS Containing : 450 g/L GLYPHOSATE or 540 g/L GLYPHOSATE as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Purpose	Rate
LINSEED (<i>Linum usitatissimum</i>)	CROP DESICCATION AT OR NEAR HARVEST	- 670 mL to 2.0 L/ha for products containing 450 g/L glyphosate - 560 mL to 1.7 L/ha for products containing 540 g/L glyphosate

Critical Use Comments:

Apply in October to January (depending on cropping region), after the crop has matured.

Apply by ground or air- follow the directions outlined on the glyphosate product labels taking care to observe temperature and application.

Apply at 90% pod fill. Follow the directions outlined on the glyphosate product labels when applying glyphosate at crop maturity.

Do not keep seed from treated crop for subsequent crop planting.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 10 DAYS after application

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food for 10 DAYS after application

Jurisdiction:

NSW, QLD, SA only

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their “control-in-use” legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise off-label use in VIC)

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

Export of Produce:

Exported produce or animals must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.
