FARMOZ SIMAZINE 500 FLOWABLE HERBICIDE
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/L SIMAZINE as their only active constituent.

NUFARM SIMAZINE 900 DF HERBICIDE
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 900 g/kg SIMAZINE as their only active constituent.

Mix in a convenient amount of water and apply when algae development is first noticed.

DO NOT empty troughs or above ground structures treated with simazine onto surrounding ground.

DO NOT use treated water for irrigation.
