FOR THE CONTROL OF GREEN CESTRUM**

GARLON 600 HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 31898)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 600g/L TRICLOPYR as the only active constituent.

Critical Use Comments:

- Basal bark application only. Refer to product label for basal bark application instructions.
- DO NOT over treat, as excessive run-off might affect adjacent trees and shrubs through root absorption.
- DO NOT apply to wet stems as this can repel the diesel mixture.
- Nitrile/neoprene gloves should be worn instead of rubber gloves.
- Poisonous plants may become more palatable after spraying. Stock should be kept away from these plants until they have died down.

Withholding Period:

NOT required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

NSW only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the permit particularly the information included in details of permit and conditions of permit.
