## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

TECTO FLOWABLE SC FUNGICIDE (APVMA No. 49910)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/L THIABENDAZOLE as the only active constituent.

### Restraint:

Do not use treated seed for human consumption or stockfood.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Sweet Potato ( <i>Ipomea batatas</i> ) – seed roots	Field rots caused by scurf ( <i>Monilochaetes infuscans</i> ) and root rot ( <i>Fusarium</i> spp.)	1. Pre-plant dip: 900 mL product/100 L water 2. Pre-storage spray: 1 L product/22 L water

### Critical Use Comments:

- Make one application only prior to planting of seed roots. Dip seed roots in the suspension at the specified rate for a duration of 1-2 minutes prior to planting.
- Make one application only prior to storing of seed roots. Apply the suspension as a fine mist over the sweet potatoes at the rate of 2 L per tonne prior to storage.

### Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

### Jurisdiction:

All states and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation does not require a permit to legalise this off-label use in that state.

### Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
