AMISTAR 250 SC FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing 250 g/L AZOXYSTROBIN as its only active constituent.

AMISTAR WG FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing 500 g/kg AZOXYSTROBIN as its only active constituent.

BAYFIDAN 250 EC FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing:250 g/L TRIADIMENOL as its only active constituent.

SAPROL FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing:190 g/L TRIFORINE as its only active constituent.

TILT 250 EC SYSTEMIC FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing:250 g/L PROPICONAZOLE as its only active constituent.

Apply by ground application only, e.g. boom, air-assisted, hand-gun.

Triadimenol may also be applied via plant bath or soil drench.

¹ An Infected premise is any land holding on which myrtle rust is present or land holdings within the immediate locale which are at risk of becoming infected.
