## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Products to be used:

GENFARM CENTAUR 100 INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 58709)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 100 g/L ALPHA-CYPERMETHRIN as the only active constituent.

### SPRAY DRIFT RESTRAINTS:

Specific definitions for terms used in this section can be found at [apvma.gov.au/spraydrift](http://apvma.gov.au/spraydrift)

DO NOT allow bystanders to come into contact with the spray cloud.

DO NOT apply in a manner that may cause an unacceptable impact to native vegetation, agricultural crops, landscaped gardens and aquaculture production, or cause contamination of plant or livestock commodities, outside the application site from spray drift. Wherever possible, correctly use application equipment designed to reduce spray drift and apply when the wind direction is away from these sensitive areas.

DO NOT apply unless the wind speed is between 3 and 20 kilometres per hour at the application site during the time of application.

DO NOT apply if there are hazardous surface temperature inversion conditions present at the application site during the time of application. Surface temperature conditions exist most evenings one to two hours before sunset and persist until one to two hours after sunrise.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Lettuce (field grown only)	Red-legged earth mite ( <i>Halotydeus destructor</i> )  Vegetable weevil ( <i>Listroderes difficilis</i> )	50 – 100 mL product / ha

### Critical Use Comments:

- DO NOT spray if rainfall is expected before the foliar spray is dry.
- DO NOT make more than two (2) foliar applications per crop at an interval of 7 days.

### Withholding Period:

Harvest: Do not harvest for 3 days after application.

### Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

### Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994*, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.
