

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF GRASS AND BROADLEAF WEEDS IN CARROTS USING SHIELDED SPRAYING EQUIPMENT

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 360 g/L GLYPHOSATE present as the ISOPROPYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituent.

WIPE-OUT 450 NON-RESIDUAL HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 39264)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 450 g/L GLYPHOSATE present as the ISOPROPYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituent.

NUFARM WEEDMASTER DST HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 62723)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 470 g/L GLYPHOSATE present as the POTASSIUM & MONO AMMONIUM SALT as the only active constituent.

KENSO AGCARE KEN-UP 500 FLEXI HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 68140)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/L GLYPHOSATE present as the ISOPROPYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituent.

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 510 g/L GLYPHOSATE present as the ISOPROPYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituent.

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 517 g/L GLYPHOSATE present as the POTASSIUM SALT as the only active constituent.

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 540 g/L GLYPHOSATE present as the POTASSIUM SALT as the only active constituent.

GLADIATOR DRY 680 WG HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 68520)

Containing: 680 g/kg GLYPHOSATE present as the MONO-AMMONIUM SALT as the only active constituent.

Containing: 875 g/kg GLYPHOSATE present as the MONO-AMMONIUM SALT as the only active constituent.

RESTRAINT:

DO NOT allow spray or spray drift to contact any part of the crop as severe injury or destruction may result. Apply only with shielded sprayer or hooded spray nozzles. DO NOT apply in crops less than 20 cm high.

DO NOT apply when the wind is light and variable in strength and direction.

DO NOT spray when wind speed is above 15 km/h.

Refer to the label of the product being used for additional restraints.

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply only with shielded sprayer or hooded spray nozzles.
- DO NOT apply in crops less than 20 cm high.
- Use a spray volume of 25-100 L/ha.
- Add wetter at recommended rates.
- DO NOT apply more than 2 applications per season.
- DO NOT apply less than 14 days after the previous treatment.
- After the first application, if the control is less than adequate and resistance is suspected then the second application should NOT be applied and other herbicide management options should be sought.

Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

Export of treated produce

Maximum Residue Limits (MRLs) have been established to allow treated produce to be used for human consumption. An MRL has been established for GLYPHOSATE in ROOT AND TUBER VEGETABLES. MRLs can be found in the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (MRL Standard) Instrument 2019*. MRLs apply only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. If treated produce is to be exported, residues must not exceed the limits/tolerances of the importing country.
