This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

ALL REGISTERED products containing GLYPHOSATE at a level of either 360, 450 or 540 g/L present as the ISOPROPYLAMINE SALT as their only active constituent

ALL REGISTERED products containing GLYPHOSATE at a level of either 450, 540 or 570 g/L present as the POTASSIUM SALT as their only active constituent

### Directions for Use:

**Restraint:** DO NOT apply treatments with ground-based or aerial spray equipment, or under weather conditions that are likely to cause spray drift onto nearby susceptible crops, pastures, or other sensitive plants, or onto natural streams, rivers, wetlands or waterways.

### Critical Use Comments:

- DO NOT spray treatment prior to petal fall.
- Apply when majority of crop is at green capsule stage and petal fall is complete.
- DO NOT apply more than one application per season.
- Observe *Restrictions* listed on this permit and the product label.

#### Ground-based Boom Application:

- Apply using a spray volume of 100 – 200 L/ha, with addition of Nufarm LI 700 Surfactant at 500 mL/100 L.
- Nozzles and pressure settings should be selected to deliver a MEDIUM or MEDIUM-COURSE droplet size in accordance with ASAE S572 “Spray Nozzle Classification by Droplet Spectra”.
- Refer to the *Application* section on product labels for further information.

#### Aerial Application:

- DO NOT apply treatments by aircraft in situations where drift onto sensitive crops and pastures is likely to occur.
- Apply using boom or Micronair equipment in a minimum spray volume of 30 L/ha and using settings to produce a median droplet diameter of 250 – 350 microns.
- Add non-ionic surfactant as per surfactant label recommendations.
- Refer to the *Application* section on *Aerial Equipment* on product labels for further information.

### Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed (refer *Timing of application* above).

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food.

**Jurisdiction:**

TAS only.

**Additional Conditions:**

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

*Export of treated produce:*

To allow treated produce to be supplied or otherwise made available for consumption, a Temporary Maximum Residue Limit (TMRL) has been established for glyphosate on Poppy Seed of T20 mg/kg. This TMRL limit applies only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. Where treated produce is to be exported, due account should be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries, and that any residues must not exceed those requirements of the importing country.
