Critical Use Comments:

- DO NOT apply more than 6 applications of methomyl per crop observing a minimum retreatment interval of 5 days between consecutive applications.
- For the effective management of fruit fly this product may be required to be used as part of a broader strategic spray program involving other products approved for the control of fruit fly in conjunction with appropriate pest monitoring. Efficacy of such spray programs may be dependent upon the significance and level of pest pressure during the season.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT harvest for 1 DAY after application.

Jurisdiction & Locations:

Growing districts of Bowen and Gumlu QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit.
