TO CONTROL POWDERY MILDEW ON MUNG BEANS

Products to be used:

BARMAC WETTABLE SULPHUR FUNGICIDE & MITICIDE PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 800 g/kg SULPHUR as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Restraints:

- DO NOT spray in hot weather
- DO NOT apply 21 days before or after an oil spray
- DO NOT mix with an oil spray

Crop	Disease	Rate
MUNGBEAN	Powdery mildew	3 kg/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Use spray volume of 100 L/ha for ground application and 30 L/ha for aerial application.
- Apply when disease is first seen (usually at the first trifolate leaf stage) and repeat as necessary up to early pod fill.

Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

NSW & QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
