CHEMAG DICAMBA - MCPA HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 54886) PLUS OTHER REGISTERD PRODUCTS Containing: 340 g/L MCPA present as the DIMETHYLAMINE SALT and 80 g/L DICAMBA present as the DIMETHYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituents.

RICHGRO BINDII & CLOVER WEEDKILLER (APVMA No. 48952) PLUS OTHER REGISTERD PRODUCTS

Containing: 150 g/L MCPA present as the DIMETHYLAMINE SALT and 25 g/L DICAMBA present as the DIMETHYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituents.

Critical Use Comments:

• Apply to actively growing weeds before viable seed is present on the plant.

Roadsides, Turfed Recreation Areas

• Apply by boomspray, knapsack or high volume application in accordance with label instructions.

Home Gardens

- Apply by handheld equipment in accordance with label instructions.
- Avoid spray drift and vapour movement onto desirable plants and susceptible crops such as tomatoes, vines, fruit trees and ornamentals.
- DO NOT allow children and pets to enter treated areas until spray has dried.

Withholding Period:

<u>Roadsides</u>, <u>Turfed recreation areas</u>: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food 7 days after application. <u>Home Gardens</u>: DO NOT feed treated grass clippings/plant material to poultry or livestock.

Jurisdiction:

NSW only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read,

or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994*, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.
