FOR CONTROL OF CERCOSPORA LEAF SPOT AND RUST DISEASES IN
FABA BEANS & BROAD BEANS

PERMIT NUMBER - PER13752

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

Product to be used:

FOLICUR 430SC FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 430 g/L TEBUCONAZOLE as their only active constituent.

BROAD BEANS (<i>Vicia faba</i> var. major)	Faba Bean Rust (<i>Uromyces vicia-fabae</i>)	

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply at first sign of disease or when conditions favour development of disease.
- Apply a maximum of three (3) spray treatments per season, at an interval of 14 – 21 days between consecutive sprays.
- Complete and thorough coverage of all foliage and other parts of the crop is essential to achieve good control.
- Using accurately calibrated equipment, apply in a spray volume of 100 L/ha for ground application, and a minimum spray volume of 30 L/ha for aerial application.
- Add *Agridex Non-ionic Surfactant* to the tank mix at a rate of 1 L product/ha.
- DO NOT apply spray under weather conditions, or from spray equipment that may cause spray drift onto nearby susceptible plants or crops, cropping lands or pastures.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 21 DAYS after the final application.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food for 14 DAYS after the final application.

Jurisdiction:

ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, TAS, NT and WA

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their 'control-of-use' legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in VIC).

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this PERMIT, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this PERMIT must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this PERMIT.
