

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

TO CONTROL MADEIRA VINE AND CAT'S CLAW CREEPER IN RIPARIAN ZONES

PERMIT NUMBER - PER13914

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

NUFARM CONOUEROR HERBICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 300 g/L TRICLOPYR present as the BUTOXYETHYL ESTER and 100 g/L PICLORAM present as the HEXYLOXYPROPYLAMINE SALT as their only active constituents.

GRAZON EXTRA HERBICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 300 g/L TRICLOPYR present as the BUTOXYETHYL ESTER, 100 g/L PICLORAM present as the HEXYLOXYPROPYLAMINE SALT and 8 g/L AMINOPYRALID present as the HEXYLOXYPROPYLAMINE SALT as their only active constituents.

RIPARIAN ZONES	Madeira vine (Anredera cordifolia)	400 mL product / 100 L water
	Cat's claw creeper (Dolichandra unguis-cati)	

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply by hand gun to vines on the ground. Juvenile Madeira vine may be detached from host, coiled on the ground and sprayed. Cat's claw creeper is difficult to detach so juvenile vines attached to the host can be sprayed with the mixture <u>providing no spray</u> comes into contact with the hosts' leaves.
- Spraying may be required once per year for Cat's claw creeper and up to three times per year for Madeira vine.
- DO NOT use within 5 metres of a waterway.
- DO NOT use the product near desirable vegetation.
- DO NOT allow spray to drift onto non-target species and sensitive areas including, but not limited to, natural streams, rivers, wetlands or waterways.
- Minimise spray drift using very coarse to coarse droplets by reducing pressure to 500 kPa (approx. 5 Bar) and using large nozzle plates in the hand gun.

Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

NSW and QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.
