## **CONDITIONS OF USE**

## **Products to be used:**

EZYCROP CHLORTHAL 750 WG HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 69085) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 750 g/kg CHLORTHAL DIMETHYL as the only active constituent.

NUFARM CHLORTHAL-DIMETHYL 900 HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 59137) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 900 g/kg CHLORTHAL DIMETHYL as the only active constituent.

#### **RESTRAINTS:**

DO NOT apply later than sowing or transplanting.

DO NOT apply over the top of the transplants.

## **Directions for Use:**

Crop	Pest	Rate
Parsley	Various broadleaf and grass weeds as per the product label.	750 g/kg product 6-15 kg/ha 900 g/kg product 5-12.5 kg/ha

#### **Critical Use Comments:**

- Apply at the time of sowing or transplanting.
- Apply via boom or spot spray.
- The lower rate is effective on lighter soils, depending on weeds to be controlled and period of control required. The higher rate is recommended for heavier soil types or if soil incorporation is required.
- Apply in at least 450 L water/ha.
- DO NOT apply more than 1 application per season.
- For field sown crops (i.e. seed sown), apply at or just prior to seeding.
- For transplants, apply before transplanting.
- In all cases, apply before weeds emerge. If weeds do emerge before application, weed or cultivate prior to spraying.

## Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: Do not graze any treated areas or cut for stock food.

#### Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

## **Additional Conditions:**

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

## To Avoid Crop Damage

The sensitivity of the crop to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable to only treat a small area to ascertain the reaction before treating the whole crop. PER14032 Version 3 Page 2 of 3

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994*, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.
