Products to be used:

ROVRAL LIQUID SEED DRESSING FUNGICIDE (APVMA No. 40394)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 250 g/L IPRADIONE as the only active constituent.

VULCAN FS SEED DRESSING FUNGICIDE (APVMA No. 55706)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/L IPRADIONE as the only active constituent.

RESTRAINTS:

DO NOT use treated seed for human or animal consumption.

DO NOT allow treated seed to contaminate food for human or animal consumption.

DO NOT feed or expose treated seed to animals including wild or domestic birds.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Disease	Rate
Broccoli	Rhizoctonia	<u>250 g/L product</u> 800 mL/100 kg seed. <u>500 g/L product</u> 400 mL/100 kg seed

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply to seed before planting.
- Mix into a slurry using enough water to ensure complete coating of the seed using commercial seed dressing equipment.
- Allow seed to dry before packing or planting.
- Comply with all product label instructions.

Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994*, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.
