Products to be used:

ECO-OIL ORGANIC MITICIDE/INSECTICIDE BOTANICAL OIL CONCENTRATE

(APVMA No. 51403)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 850 g/L EMULSIFIABLE BOTANICAL OILS as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

| Crop | Pest | Rate |

| Green house and hydroponic capsicums, cucumbers, and lettuce | Silverleaf whitefly (<i>Bemisia tabaci</i> biotype B) | 75 mL per 15 L knapsack OR 500 mL/100 L |

Critical Use Comments:

- Regularly monitor plants for whiteflies and apply when they first appear.
- Apply 2 sprays 3-5 days apart.
- Use the higher rate when numbers are high.
- Repeat application at signs of reinfestation, but not within 7 days of last spray.
- DO NOT apply if the temperature is above 35°C.
- DO NOT apply to plants suffering from heat or moisture stress.
- In capsicum and cucumber, DO NOT apply more than 3 sprays to plants within a 4 to 8 week period.

Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994*, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section

To Avoid Crop Damage

The sensitivity of the crop to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable to only treat a small area to ascertain the reaction before treating the whole crop.
