## PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF HAWKWEED IN IDENTIFIED AREAS OF KOSCIUSZKO NATIONAL PARK AND ADJOINING LANDS

# **PERMIT NUMBER – PER14301**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows the Permit Holder and any person stipulated below to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

## **CONDITIONS OF USE**

## **Products to be used:** TORDON GRANULES WEED & BRUSH HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 31430) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS Containing: 20 g/kg PICLORAM as the only active constituent.

### **Directions for Use:**

Situation	Weed	Rate
Kosciuszko National Park and lands in the Snowy Monaro Regional Council area only.	Hawkweed ( <i>Hieracium</i> spp.)	45 g/m <sup>2</sup> (granule application)

### **Critical Use Comments:**

- Adhere to ALL product label Restraint, Precaution and Protection statements.
- DO NOT make more than one application per year.
- DO NOT apply when hawkweed is stressed due to periods of extreme cold i.e. winter.
- Sprinkle granules evenly in a 2 m x 2 m plot, with the above-ground plant parts (e.g. rosettes) located in the centre of the plot. (This is to treat the below-ground stolons which can be >1 m long).
- Apply by hand or using a shaker or hand-held spreader.
- DO NOT use within 10 metres of a waterway.
- DO NOT treat sphagnum bogs.
- DO NOT apply within 5 m from sphagnum communities.
- A Conservation Risk Assessment (CRA) MUST be undertaken at all locations prior to treatment.

### Jurisdiction:

NSW only.

### **Additional Conditions:**

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
