

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF SALVINIA AND WATER HYACINTH IN AQUATIC SITUATIONS

PERMIT NUMBER – PER14327

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. Products to be used:

ROUNDUP BIACTIVE HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 48518)

Containing: 360 g/L GLYPHOSATE present as the isopropylamine salt as the only active constituent.

NUFARM WEEDMASTER DUO DUAL SALT TECHNOLOGY HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 53576)

Containing: 360 g/L GLYPHOSATE present as the isopropylamine & mono-ammonium salts as the only active constituent.

ENVIROMAX GLYPHOSATE 700 SG HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 68764)

Containing: 700 g/kg GLYPHOSATE present as the mono-ammonium salt as the only active constituent.

NUFARM BONUS ADJUVANT/SURFACTANT (APVMA No. 52431)

Containing: 114 g/L ALKYLETHOXYPHOSPHATE, TROLAMINE SALT as the only active constituent.

NEMO AQUATIC SURFACTANT (APVMA No. 67157)

Containing: 315g/L COCAMIDOPROPYL BETAINE as the only active constituent.

AND OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS containing as the only active constituent(s) the same concentration of active as stated above AND that are REGISTERED FOR CONTROL OF EMERGED WEEDS IN ALL BODIES OF FRESH AND BRACKISH WATER WHICH MAY BE FLOWING, NON-FLOWING OR TRANSIENT.

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply in strict accordance with all label instructions for use in aquatic areas to minimise the amount of spray entering the water.
- DO NOT apply this product within 0.5 km up-stream of potable water intake in flowing water (i.e. river or stream, etc.) or within 0.5 km of a potable water intake in a standing body of water such as a lake, pond or reservoir.
- Apply by boom, handgun, knapsack or aerially (helicopter) a maximum of 4 times per year.

- Applications to moving bodies of water should be made while travelling upstream whenever possible to prevent concentration of the herbicide in water.
- When making any bankside applications, DO NOT overspray more than 0.5 m into open water. Avoid spraying across moving bodies of water, or where weeds do not exist.
- When applying aerially, adhere to the product label directions to minimise off-target exposure to drift and use a droplet size of 300 micron vmd and minimum spray volume of 50 L/ha.
- Treatment may result in severe oxygen depletion, which would have an adverse effect on aquatic wildlife. Care should be exercised and, where possible, mitigation measures implemented when treating enclosed water bodies that are more than 50% covered by weed or in climatic conditions which contribute to low dissolved oxygen levels.

NSW only.

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
