This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

BASAGRAN POST-EMERGENT HERBICIDE

Containing: 480 g/L BENTAZONE as its only active constituent.

BLAZER SELECTIVE HERBICIDE

Containing: 224 g/L ACIFLUORFEN as its only active constituent.

STOMP 440 HERBICIDE

Containing: 440 g/L PENDIMETHALIN as its only active constituent.

STATUS HERBICIDE

Containing: 240 g/L CLETHODIM as its only active constituent.

SENCOR 700 WG HERBICIDE

Containing: 700 g/kg METRIBUZIN as its only active constituent.

SPINNAKER 700 WDG HERBICIDE

Containing: 700 g/kg IMAZETHAPYR as its only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

The use of this permit is to allow the registered use of soybean use patterns in others states for the products listed above under '**Products to be used**' on soybean crops in Tasmania.

Refer to and follow the above registered product labels directions for use for the use on soybeans at registered rates and weed coverage.

Critical Use Comments:

Refer to and follow critical use comments as displayed on the the product label for soybean.

Withholding Period:

Refer to and follow the Withholding periods as specified on the product label for soybean.

Jurisdiction:

TAS only.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

Crop Sensitivity and Tolerance:

The sensitivity and tolerance of Soybeans to products included under this permit has not been fully evaluated for Tasmanian conditions. Some important information refers to particular soil types, weather conditions, soil moisture etc. Reading the particular label is essential to reducing the risk of crop damage. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.

Export of Produce:

Users should be aware that some export markets may apply residue tolerance limits different to those within Australia. Users should determine if appropriate residue tolerance limits are established in the importing countries and any residues do not exceed those tolerance limits.
