### Product to be used:

TOMAHAWK HERBICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 750g/L METRIBUZIN as their only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Weeds	Rate
Chickpeas and Lentils	<i>As per product label for Chickpeas and Lentils including:</i> Capeweed, Doublegee, Geranium, Mustard, Toad Rush, Turnip, Wild Radish, Wireweed, Annual Ryegrass, Barley Grass, and Brome Grass	180g/ha (Light sandy soils, ie., sandy loams to loamy sands).
		280g/ha (medium soils, loam, silt plus clay 40-60%).
		380g/ha (heavy soils, clay loams, silt plus clay over 60%).

### Critical Use Comments:

- Adhere to all product label **Restraints, Precaution and Protection** statements
- Apply by boom spray only
- ONLY apply post sowing, pre-emergence at least 5 cm deep.
- DO NOT apply post-emergence as crop injury will occur.
- DO NOT apply to chickpeas grown on sandy soils, i.e. silt plus clay less than 40%.
- The vigour of lentils may be reduced, especially if heavy rain falls after spraying.
- Weeds: Weeds should be from pre-emergence to 3 leaf stage except Wireweed (Hogweed) which should not be beyond the cotyledon stage. Best results for grass and Wireweed control are obtained when rain or irrigation follows within a few days of spraying.

**Harvest:** NOT REQUIRED WHEN USED AS DIRECTED

### Jurisdiction:

TAS only.

### Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
