

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF ALLIGATOR WEED IN DOMESTIC GARDEN SITUATIONS

PERMIT NUMBER - PER14733

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows the Permit Holder and any person stipulated below to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

Persons trained or experienced in the preparation and use of agricultural chemicals.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

ROUNDUP BIACTIVE HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 48518)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 360 g/L GLYPHOSATE PRESENT AS THE ISOPROPYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituent.

CASORON 4G HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 69139)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 40 g/kg DICHLOBENIL as the only active constituent.

NUFARM ASSOCIATE HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 46361)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 600 g/kg METSULFURON-METHYL as the only active constituent.

RESTRAINTS:

40 g/kg Dichlobenil Products (e.g. Casoron 4G Herbicide)

DO NOT apply where plants are grown for human or animal consumption.

DO NOT graze livestock (including poultry) in treated areas.

DO NOT apply to annual plants.

DO NOT apply during periods of intense rainfall, when wind speed exceeds 30 kph or under conditions which cause granule movement to non-target areas.

DO NOT dispense via dust prone methods.

600 g/kg Metsulfuron-methyl Products (e.g. Nufarm Associate Herbicide)

DO NOT apply where plants are grown for human or animal consumption.

DO NOT apply if rainfall is expected within 4 hours.

DO NOT apply to weeds that are under stress.

Directions for Use:

Situation	Pest	Rate
Home gardens in residential areas (Urban backyards)	Alligator Weed (Alternanthera philoxeroides)	Glyphosate: 10 mL product / 1 L water Dichlobenil: 43 - 63 g product / square metre Metsulfuron-methyl: 1 g product / 10 L water

Critical Use Comments:

- Use under this permit is for terrestrial (non-aquatic) applications only.
- DO NOT use metsulfuron methyl or dichlobenil when replanting of treated areas is required. When replanting is required, use glyphosate only.
- Avoid soil contamination that may lead to surface or ground water contamination. Users must comply with the NSW *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997*.
- DO NOT apply from equipment or under conditions that could cause product to come into contact with nearby susceptible plants/crops. Refer to warning on product labels.
- Persons using product under this permit MUST notify property owners (or occupiers) as follows:
 - a) Notification of any product application that occurs on their property under this permit.
- b) Notification that the treated weed is not to be used for any purpose after product Version 4 Page 2 of 3

- application has occurred.
- c) Notification that metsulfuron-methyl and dichlobenil are soil residual products therefore plant back restrictions apply.

Glyphosate & Metsulfuron-methyl:

- ONLY use glyphosate herbicides that are approved for use in aquatic areas.
- DO NOT apply to weeds that are not actively growing.
- Use coarse spray droplets from low pressure hand application equipment only. Avoid atomisation due to high pressure.
- Wet leaf area of alligator weed only.
- Avoid run-off to soil.

Dichlobenil:

- Treatment should be carried out when plants are dormant usually in the colder months.
- Apply granules evenly over the area to be treated.
- Use the higher rate for heavier weed infestations.

Withholding Period:

Glyphosate only

Grazing: not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

NSW only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994*, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.
