

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF HAWKWEED IN PASTURES AND NON-CROP SITUATIONS

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

Products to be used:

EUREKA! TRICLOPYR PICLORAM HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 87845) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 300 g/L TRICLOPYR PRESENT AS THE BUTOXYETHYL ESTER and 100 g/L PICLORAM PRESENT AS THE HEXYLOXYPROPYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituents.

GRAZON EXTRA HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 60830)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 300 g/L TRICLOPYR PRESENT AS THE BUTOXYETHYL ESTER, 100g/L PICLORAM PRESENT AS THE HEXYLOXYPROPYLAMINE SALT and 8 g/L AMINOPYRALID PRESENT AS HEXYLOXYPROPYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituents.

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply to actively growing plants, before flowering.
- Use the higher specified rate if vegetation is dense.
- DO NOT over-apply under trees and near other sensitive vegetation.
- DO NOT spray other sensitive vegetation.
- DO NOT apply more than once per season.
- Note label warnings about susceptible follow up crops and Protection of Livestock.
- Non-grass pasture will be damaged by the spray.

Withholding Period:

OBSERVE THE APPLICABLE WITHHOLDING PERIOD AND EXPORT INTERVAL STATEMENTS ON THE PRODUCT LABEL.

NSW ONLY.
