



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

PERMIT NUMBER -PER6627

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

DUAL GOLD HERBICIDE

containing: 960 g/L S-METOLACHLOR as its only active constituent, or any other registered product with the same level of S-metolachlor as its only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
AZUKI BEANS (<i>Vigna angularis</i>)	COMMON SOW THISTLE AND OTHER WEEDS AS LISTED ON THE LABEL. (e.g. Blackberry Nightshade, Fat Hen Fat Hen and Barnyard Grass).	1.5-2.0 L/ha

Critical Use Comments:

DO NOT apply by aircraft.

Apply before, at or immediately after planting and before crops and weeds germinate : see Critical Comments for Green Beans and Navy Beans on the Dual Gold label for further instructions on application and post-application operations.

Use lower rates in soils with high sand and silt content or low in organic matter.

Apply in a minimum of 60 L-water per hectare.

Note follow-crop restrictions on the Dual Gold label.

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.

Withholding Period (WHP):

HARVEST : NOT REQUIRED WHEN USED AS DIRECTED.

GRAZING/STOCK-FEED : DO NOT GRAZE OR CUT FOR STOCK-FEED FOR 13 WEEKS AFTER APPLICATION.

Jurisdiction:

NSW only.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the full details of this permit.

EXPORT OF PRODUCE:

Exported produce or animals must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.

APPROVAL ONTO A PRODUCT-LABEL:

The permit holder **must** make bona fide efforts to have this use approved onto the relevant product-label, during the currency of this permit. Adequate documentation of these efforts **must** accompany any request for renewal of this permit. Note that any decision on renewal will depend on the efforts made and reasons for failure of those efforts.
