



**PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT
FOR THE CONTROL OF BAHIA GRASS AND FIREWEED**

PERMIT NUMBER –PER80063

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

Product to be used:

FARMOZ LYNX 600 HERBICIDE

METSUN 600 HERBICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS containing

600 g/kg METSULFURON-METHYL as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Weeds	Rate
PASTURES, ROADSIDES, NON-CROP AREAS, RIGHTS OF WAY, FORESTS, RESERVES AND BUSHLANDS.	BAHIA GRASS AND FIREWEED	40 g/ha (boomspray) OR 10 g/100L (spot spray)

Critical Use Comments:

Apply only one application per year by boom or spot spray. For best results apply in Autumn. Peak control may take 3 to 6 months, particularly for Bahia grass.

A follow up application should be made in the following growing season to control plants and seedlings that survived the initial application.

Boomspray in a volume of 100L water per hectare.

Spot spray with powered handgun / knapsack in at least 1000L water per hectare.

This treatment is not suited to areas that have more than 80% ground cover of Bahia grass. A competitive pasture (at least 20% ground cover) must be present to provide competition after Bahia grass is controlled. Treated pastures must be grazed lightly or rested to facilitate maximum pasture establishment. Pasture improvement (fertilisers and sowing of competitive varieties) will assist long-term control.

Note: legume components of pasture will die, however the desirable grass component is only temporarily set-back for one month.
