Product to be used:

CUSTODIA FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 120 g/L AZOXYSTROBIN and 200 g/L TEBUCONAZOLE as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Chickpeas and lentils	Ascochyta blight (<i>Ascochyta</i> spp) and Grey mould (<i>Botrytis</i> spp.)	1.0 L/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply a maximum of 2 foliar applications per crop by boom spray or equivalent with spray volume of 100L/ha by ground and at least 30 L/ha by air with a minimum re-treatment interval of 14 days.
- Apply at first sign of disease.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 28 DAYS after application.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food for 21 DAYS after application

ALL States

Additional Conditions:

This Permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
