This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. Product to be used:

SUMITOMO SHIELD SYSTEMIC INSECTICIDE
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 200 g/L CLOTHIANIDIN as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Mung beans and Navy beans	Redbanded shield bug (<i>Piezodorus oceanicus</i>) and Green vegetable bug (<i>Nezara viridula</i>)	125-375 mL/ha plus MAXX Organosilicone Surfactant™ at 2 mL/L of water Spray volume: Ground: 100 L/ha Aerial: 30 L/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Monitor crops and commence applications once local thresholds are reached. Continue to monitor crops and DO NOT apply more than 2 applications per crop with a minimum re-treatment interval of 7 days between consecutive applications.
- Apply as a foliar spray via boom spray or aerial.
- Effective control of insect pests requires an integrated approach. Refer to CropLife Australia's Insecticide Resistance Management Strategies for further information (<http://www.croplife.org.au/resistance-strategy/2015-insecticide-resistance-management-strategies/>).
- **DO NOT** apply to crops when in flower.
- Observe all label 'Spray Drift Restraints' and 'Mandatory No-Spray Zones' as contained on the product label for aerial or ground application.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 21 days after application

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for livestock

Jurisdiction:

NSW and QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

TO AVOID CROP DAMAGE:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.

Export of Produce:

Exported produce must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.
