## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

K-OBIOL COMBI SYNERGISED GRAIN PROTECTANT

Containing: 50 g/L DELTAMETHRIN plus 400 g/L PIPERONYL BUTOXIDE  
as the only active constituents.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Insect Pest	Rate
Canola and Sunflower seed (for sowing only)	Stored insect pests (as per product label)	2 L product / 100 L water  Applied at the rate of 1 L diluted spray per tonne of seed.

### Critical Use Comments:

Apply once only at bagging.

### Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

### Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit as their *Control-of-Use* legislation does not require a permit to legalise this off-label use in that state.

### Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.

All seed treated under this permit must be dyed with a distinctive colour and clearly labelled to industry standards to enable treated seed to be readily distinguished from untreated seed.

DO NOT supply or use treated seed for animal or human consumption.

All bags containing treated seed for sowing must be clearly identified as containing seed that has been treated.

DO NOT allow treated seed to contaminate other seed intended for animal or human consumption.

DO NOT feed or expose wild or domestic birds to treated seed.
