## **PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT**

**PERMIT NUMBER -PER8443**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

### **CONDITIONS OF USE**

**Product to be used:**

ALL REGISTERED PRODUCTS containing 360 g/L GLYPHOSATE and 450 g/L GLYPHOSATE as their only active constituents.

**Directions for Use:**

<b>Situation</b>	<b>Pest</b>	<b>Rate</b>
FALLOW, PASTURE, NON-ARABLE AREAS (PUBLIC LAND, NATIONAL PARKS)	BLUE HELIOTROPE ( <i>Heliotropium amplexicaule</i> )	<p><b>HIGH VOLUME/SPOT SPRAY</b> 360g/L products: apply at a rate of 1L product per 100L water .</p> <p><b>BOOM SPRAY</b> 360 g/L products: apply at a rate of 2 L product per hectare.</p> <p>450 g/L products: apply at a rate of 1.6 - 2.0 L product per hectare.</p>

**Critical Use Comments:**

Spray when plants are actively growing from late spring to autumn. Blue heliotrope plants will have commenced flowering and before seed set. Do not apply under stressed conditions from lack of moisture or in high temperatures.

High volume/Spot spray

Spray to thoroughly wet all foliage.

Boom Spray

Spraying is best carried out early morning while temperatures are low. Blue heliotrope plants will stress quickly during periods of high temperatures even if there is adequate moisture.

**Additional Conditions:**

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the permit particularly the information included in DETAILS OF PERMIT and CONDITIONS OF PERMIT.

Apart from the uses dealt with in this permit users must comply with the instructions on the approved label of the registered product, particularly those instructions relating to protection, precaution, safety directions, first aid and storage and disposal.
