CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

ALL REGISTERED PRODUCTS which contain 600 g/kg METSULFURON METHYL as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Situation	Pest	Rate
FALLOW, PASTURE, NON-ARABLE AREAS (PUBLIC LAND, NATIONAL PARKS)	BLUE HELIOTROPE (<i>Heliotropium amplexicaule</i>)	SPOT SPRAY at 10 grams product per 100L water, plus 0.1% surfactant.

Critical Use Comments:

Spray when plants are actively growing from late spring to autumn. Blue heliotrope plants will have commenced flowering and before seed set. Do not apply under stressed conditions from lack of moisture or in high temperatures.

Spot spray

Spray to thoroughly wet all foliage.

Jurisdiction:

Additional Conditions:

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the permit particularly the information included in DETAILS OF PERMIT and CONDITIONS OF PERMIT.
