



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

Product to be used:

RAPTOR WG HERBICIDE

Containing:700g/kg IMAZAMOX as its only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate/ha
ADZUKI BEANS OR AZUKI BEANS (<i>Vigna angularis</i>)	FOR POST-EMERGENT CONTROL OF CERTAIN GRASS AND BROADLEAF WEEDS AS PER THE REGISTERED LABEL	50g plus BS 1000 (or equivalent) at 200 mL per 100L water

Critical Use Comments:

Do not apply to crops beyond the 6 leaf stage

Do not apply by aircraft or by mister.

Do not apply Raptor WG Herbicide more than once per season.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed

Grazing: Do not graze or cut for stock food for 6 weeks after application

Jurisdiction:

ALL States

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

TO AVOID CROP DAMAGE:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.

RESIDUES:

To allow produce from treated plants or animals to be supplied or otherwise made available for human or animal consumption the APVMA has established the following temporary maximum residue limits (TMRLs):

Imazamox	Adzuki bean (dry)	T*0.05
	Adzuki bean forage and fodder [fresh weight]	T*0.05

Export of Produce:

Exported produce or animals must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.
