LENTILS**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

SYSTIVA SEED TREATMENT FUNGICIDE

Containing: 333 g/L FLUXAPYROXAD as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Disease	Rate
Chickpeas and Lentils	Damping Off Disease (<i>Rhizoctonia solani</i> and <i>Fusarium solani</i>) Suppression only And Ascochyta blight (<i>Ascochyta rabei</i>) Suppression only	30ml/100 kg seed

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply with a calibrated applicator designed for liquid seed treatment.
- Apply diluted with sufficient water to ensure even coverage of seed.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food for 4 weeks after application.

LIVESTOCK DESTINED FOR EXPORT MARKETS

The grazing withholding period only applies to stock slaughtered for the domestic market. Some export markets apply different standards. To meet these standards, ensure that in addition to complying with the grazing withholding period, the Export Slaughter Interval is observed before stock are sold or slaughtered..

EXPORT SLAUGHTER INTERVAL (ESI) – 2 DAYS

LIVESTOCK THAT HAVE BEEN GRAZED ON, OR FED TREATED FORAGE, FODDER OR STUBBLE SHOULD BE PLACED ON CLEAN FEED FOR 2 DAYS PRIOR TO EXPORT SLAUGHTER

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit as their *Control-of-Use* legislation means that an APVMA permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that state.

Additional Conditions:

This Permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.

Export of treated produce

Use of fluxapyroxad may result in detectable residues in Chickpeas and Lentils and not all countries have established tolerances for fluxapyroxad in these commodities. If treated produce is to be exported due account should therefore be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries and that any residues must not exceed those requirements.
