**FOR SEED TREATMENT TO CONTROL VARIOUS FUNGAL DISEASES IN  
CHICKPEAS AND LENTILS**

**PERMIT NUMBER – PER84641**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code, scheduled to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994* (the Agvet Code) of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

EVERGOL XTEND SEED TREATMENT

Containing: 154 g/L PENFLUFEN and 154 g/L TRIFLOXYSTROBIN as its only active constituents.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Plant Disease	Rate
CHICKPEAS	Rhizoctonia damping off and root rot ( <i>Rhizoctonia solani</i> )	35 mL product / 100 kg seed
LENTILS	Fusarium damping off and root rot ( <i>Fusarium</i> spp.)	
	Seedling blight ( <i>Botrytis cinerea</i> )	
	<u>Suppression only</u> Ascochyta ( <i>Ascochyta</i> spp.)	

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply one (1) application only as seed treatment prior to sowing.
- Ensure *EverGol Extend* is mixed with sufficient water to achieve even coverage of seed.
- *EverGol Xtend* may only provide suppression of seed borne *Ascochyta* caused by *Ascochyta* spp.

### Withholding Period:

Harvest: NOT REQUIRED WHEN USED AS DIRECTED.

Grazing: DO NOT GRAZE OR CUT FOR STOCK FEED WITHIN 6 WEEKS OF SOWING.

### Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation does not require a permit to legalise this off-label use in that state.

### Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.
