Critical Use Comments:

Always apply with D-C-trate at 2L/100L or Hasten or kwickin at 1L/100L or Uptake at 500mL/100L spray volume.

The lower doses will provide effective control if applied under ideal conditions to weed that are smaller, actively growing and free from temperature or water stress.

Persons applying pesticides by aircraft in NSW must hold a current NSW pilot (pesticide rating) licence and be employed or engaged by the holder of an aircraft (pesticide applicator) licence.
