Product to be used:

APHIDEX WG APHICIDE (61595)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/kg PIRIMICARB as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use Table:

Crop	Pest	Rate
BROAD BEAN/FABA BEAN (green and dry) VETCH	BEAN APHID (<i>Megoura crassicauda</i>)	250 g/ha

Critical comments:

- Apply as a foliar spray when aphids are detected at damaging levels, using a boom sprayer, knapsack or similar equipment using sufficient water volume to ensure good coverage.
- Apply a maximum of two (2) applications per crop with a minimum 15 day interval between consecutive applications.

Withholding Periods:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest within six (6) weeks of last application

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for livestock within six (6) weeks of last application
