

PERMIT TO ALLOW EMERGENCY USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT TO CONTROL BEAN APHIDS IN BROAD BEANS/FABA BEANS AND VETCH

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. Product to be used:

LORSBAN 500 EC INSECTICIDE (32887) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500g/L CHLORPYRIFOS as their only active constituent

Directions for Use:

Restraints: DO NOT apply to broad beans or faba beans (dry) after seedling emergence

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply using a boomspray or knapsack or equivalent equipment at a water adequate to provide thorough coverage.
- Apply a maximum one (1) application per season.
- Dangerous to bees. DO NOT spray while bees are actively foraging on and around the treatment area.
- DO NOT apply if heavy rains or storms that are likely to cause surface runoff are forecast in the immediate area within two days of application.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest within 14 days of last application.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for livestock within 2 days of last application.
