FOR CONTROL OF BEAN APHID IN BROAD BEANS/FABA BEANS AND VETCH

Product to be used:

KARATE ZEON INSECTICIDE (51422)
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 250 g/L LAMBDA-CYHALOTHRIN as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Insect Pest	Rate
Broad Bean/Faba Bean (green and dry) Vetch	Bean Aphid (<i>Megoura crassicauda</i>)	36 mL/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Monitor crops regularly and apply as needed to manage pest outbreaks.
- Apply a maximum of two (2) applications per crop using knapsack, boomspray or equivalent equipment with a minimum re-treatment interval of 7 days.
- Apply in sufficient water to ensure complete and thorough coverage of foliage and/or crop.
- DO NOT apply if rainfall is imminent within six (6) hours of application.
- DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with lambda-cyhalothrin product or used containers.
- TOXIC to bees. DO NOT spray while bees are actively foraging on and around the treatment area. The risk to bees may be reduced by spraying in the early morning or late evening while bees are not foraging, provided that surface temperature inversion conditions are not present.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest within 7 DAYS of application.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for livestock within 7 DAYS of application.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
