PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

**FOR SEED TREATMENT TO CONTROL VARIOUS FUNGAL DISEASES CAUSED
BY FUSARIUM SPECIES IN PULSE CROPS AND SOYBEANS**

PERMIT NUMBER – PER85449

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code, scheduled to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994* (the Agvet Code) of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

EVERGOL PRIME SEED TREATMENT AND IN-FURROW FUNGICIDE (64744)

Containing: 240 g/L PENFLUFEN as the only active constituent

Directions for Use:

Chickpeas Lentils Lupins Soybeans	Fusarium wilt (<i>Fusarium oxysporum f. sp. ciceris</i> , <i>Fusarium oxysporum f. sp. lentis</i> , <i>Fusarium oxysporum f. sp. lupine</i> , <i>Fusarium oxysporum f. sp. glycines</i>) Sudden Death Syndrome (<i>Fusarium solani f. spp. glycines</i>)	21 mL product / 100 kg seed

Critical Use Comments:

- To be used only in the event of an incursion of an exotic disease causing pathogen.
- Apply one (1) application only as seed treatment prior to sowing
- Apply dilute in water using specialized seed treatment equipment to ensure uniform coverage on seed.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stockfeed within 5 weeks of sowing.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation does not require a permit to legalise this off-label use in that state.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.
