Product to be used:

NUFARM ENDOSULFAN 350 EC INSECTICIDE
ENDOSAN EMULSIFIABLE CONCENTRATE INSECTICIDE
THIODAN EC INSECTICIDE
FARMOZ ENDOSULFAN 350 EC INSECTICIDE
Containing:350 g/L ENDOSULFAN as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Sunflower and sorghum for seed production only	Rutherglen bugs (<i>Nysius vinitor</i>)	2.1 L/ha

Critical Use Comments:

Apply when pest numbers reach thresholds.

Ensure appropriate drift management techniques are used as per the label instructions. Users in the Ord River Irrigation Area must follow the Ord River Endosulfan Protocol to further minimise the chance of endosulfan movement off-farm.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or feed fodder, stubble, trash or any treated plant material to livestock. DO NOT cut for stock feed.

Jurisdiction:

NSW, QLD, NT, WA only

Locations:

Only those areas where the permit holder has control of all material resulting from the use described in this permit.

Additional Conditions:

Use:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label, including the restraints, the conditions of use on cotton, record keeping, application techniques, high volume large-droplet placement technique specifications, aerial equipment, ground based equipment, precautions, protection statements, storage and disposal, safety directions, and first aid instructions.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

Fate of produce from treated plants:

Seed from treated plants must only be used as seed for planting. Produce from plants treated during the trial must not be supplied to or otherwise made available for human or animal consumption. The produce plus other plant material must therefore be disposed of appropriately.

The permit holder must have arrangements in place to enable control of all material from treated crops to ensure treated plant material is not made available for human or animal consumption.
