## **PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

**Product to be used:**

**K-OBIOL 250 SC GRAIN PROTECTANT**

Containing: 250 g/L DELTAMETHRIN as their only active constituent.

**Directions for Use:**

<b>Crop</b>	<b>Pest</b>	<b>Rate</b>
sunflower seed (for sowing only)	stored insect pests (as per product label)	400mL / 100L water plus 1L pipbut 800 EC / 100L water, applied in tandem.

**Critical Use Comments:**

Apply once only at bagging.

**Withholding Period:**

Not required when used as directed.

**Jurisdiction:**

ALL States except Victoria

**(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their ‘control-of-use’ legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in VIC).**

**Additional Conditions:**

1. PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the permit particularly the information included in DETAILS OF PERMIT and CONDITIONS OF PERMIT.
2. THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
3. All seed treated under this permit must be dyed a distinctive colour and clearly labelled to industry standards to enable treated seed to be readily distinguished from untreated seed.
4. Treated seed must not be used for animal or human consumption.
5. Treated seed must not be allowed to contaminate other seed intended for animal or human consumption.
6. Treated seed must not be fed or exposed to wild or domestic birds.
