PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

SUMI-ALPHA FLEX INSECTICIDE

Plus other registered products containing 50 g/L ESFENVALERATE as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
LENTILS	LUCERNE SEED WEB MOTH (<i>Etiella behrii</i>)	Apply when infestation reaches an economically damaging level and repeat if necessary. Use the <u>130mL/ha</u> rate when larvae are less than 1cm in length. Use the <u>200 mL/ha</u> rate when larvae between 1 and 2cm in length. Use the <u>300 mL/ha</u> rate when larvae longer than 2cm are present.

Critical Use Comments:

- Control moths prior to egg lay on pods.
- If control has not been obtained prior to egg lay, control larvae whilst small before boring into pods and prior to the establishment of web lined shelters.
- Spray only when monitoring indicates the presence of *Etiella*.
- DO NOT apply esfenvalerate to lentils bordered by other crops where pests are being controlled by predators or parasitoids.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT HARVEST FOR 14 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

DO NOT GRAZE FOR 7 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

Jurisdiction:

ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, TAS, NT, WA

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their ‘control-of-use’ legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in VIC).

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the permit particularly the information included in DETAILS OF PERMIT and CONDITIONS OF PERMIT.
