CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

THIMET 100G SYSTEMIC GRANULAR INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 33071) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 100 g/kg PHORATE as the only active constituent.

THIMET 200G SYSTEMIC GRANULAR INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 41439) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 200 g/kg PHORATE as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

EGGPLANT PEPPERS (Including chillies, capsicums & paprika) SHALLOTS SPRING ONIONS	APHIDS, JASSIDS, MITES, THRIPS, ONION MAGGOT	100 g/kg phorate products Apply 10 – 15 kg product per hectare 200 g/kg phorate products Apply 5 – 7.5 kg product per hectare

Critical Use Comments:

- Eggplant and Peppers apply as per the label directions for tomatoes. Distribute granules evenly in the furrow at planting time.
- Shallots & Spring onions apply as per the label directions for onions. Apply granules as a band at sowing or to established plants in 5cm band each side of growing crop.
 Incorporate into soil where possible or apply when rain is expected, or overhead irrigation can be made. Avoid contact with seed.
- DO NOT apply more than 1 application per year.
- Very dangerous. Product can kill if absorbed by skin, inhaled or swallowed. This product is too hazardous for use in the home garden.
- Remove unprotected persons and domestic animals from the operating area. Keep livestock out for 10 weeks. Take precautions to prevent birds, domestic animals and people from recovering granules from the soil surface.
- Dangerous to fish and Crustacea. DO NOT contaminate streams, waterways or rivers with the product or used containers. DO NOT leave granules on soil surface.
- Refer to 'Insecticide Resistance Warning' on label for information on resistance management.

Withholding Period:

Eggplant and Peppers

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 10 WEEKS after application.

Shallots and Spring onions

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 8 WEEKS after application.

Additional Conditions:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

The active constituent covered by this permit, phorate, is nominated and prioritised for consideration under the APVMA chemical review process. Continued issuance of this permit is subject to outcomes of any APVMA review of phorate.
