Product to be used:

RAPTOR WG HERBICIDE

And all other products containing: 700.00 g ai/kg IMAZAMOX as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Purpose	Rate
FABA BEANS AND BROAD BEANS (VICA FABA)	FOR POST-EMERGENT CONTROL OF GRASSES AND BROADLEAF WEEDS (refer to the product label)	45 g/ha

Critical Use Comments:

Spray at the 3-6 node growth stage of faba beans, approximately 30-40 days after sowing.

Use only 1 spray per annum.

Do not use adjuvants other than BS 1000 or equivalent.

Do not use oil or mix with other products containing emulsifying agents.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut stock feed for 6 weeks after application.

NSW, SA

Additional Conditions:

This permit has been issued for the stated period but there will be a concerted attempt to work with the manufacturers to transfer the use to the registered label during the life of this permit.
