Product to be used:

RAPTOR WG HERBICIDE which contains 700 g/kg IMAZAMOX as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

FABA BEAN (<i>Vicia faba</i>)	CONTROL: MUSTARD, WILD TURNIP, LUPIN, VOLUNTEER CEREALS, BARLEY GRASS, BROME GRASS SUPPRESSION: DOUBLEGEE, E, WILDRADISH, WIREWEED	Up to 45 g/ha of Raptor WG (Equivalent to 31.5 g a.i./ha)

Critical Use Comments:

Spray at 3 - 6 node growth stage of faba beans, approximately 30 - 40 days after sowing.

Use only 1 spray per annum.

Do not use adjuvants other than BS 1000 or equivalent.

Do not use oil or mix with other products containing emulsifying agents.

Withholding Period:

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: Do not graze or cut for stock food for 6 weeks after application.
