PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

PERMIT NUMBER -PER9633

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

AMISTAR WG FUNGICIDE

Containing: 500 g/kg AZOXYSTROBIN as its only active constituent.

or

AMISTAR 250 SC FUNGICIDE

Containing: 250 g/L AZOXYSTROBIN as its only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Brassica leafy vegetables <i>including:</i> pak choi bok choi choi sum gai lum/gai lan/kai lan pet sai/wong bok/haksukai mizuna komatsuma kale indian mustard kai choi gai choi/am soi tat soi and leafy mustard only.	Alternaria leaf spot	For AMISTAR WG FUNGICIDE apply 200 g of product per ha or For AMISTAR 250 SC FUNGICIDE apply 400 mL of product per ha

Critical Use Comments:

Apply a maximum of 3 applications per season. Apply by boom spray or equivalent. Apply in sufficient volume of water to achieve thorough coverage of all foliage.

Apply either product (AMISTAR WG FUNGICIDE or AMISTAR 250 SC FUNGICIDE) in a protective spray program.

The total number of Group K Fungicide sprays should be no more than 1/3 the total number of fungicide sprays per season.

DO NOT apply more than 2 consecutive applications of a Group K Fungicide. If 2 consecutive applications of a Group K Fungicide are applied they must be followed by at least the same number of sprays from an alternative chemical group.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT harvest for 1 day after application.

Jurisdiction:

ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, TAS, NT and WA only.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

TO AVOID CROP DAMAGE:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.

Export of Produce:

Exported produce or animals must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.
