FARMOZ PROMETRYN 500 FLOWABLE HERBICIDE

Containing 500.00 g/L PROMETRYN as the only active constituent.

NUFARM PROMETRYN 900 DF HERBICIDE

Containing 900.00 g/kg PROMETRYN as the only active constituent.

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing 500.00 g/L or 900.00 g/kg PROMETRYN as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

AZUKI (ADZUKI) BEANS (<i>Vigna angularis</i>)	THE FOLLOWING GRASS AND BROADLEAF WEEDS (BARNYARD GRASS, BATHURST BURR, BELLVINE, BLACK BERRY NIGHTSHADE, BLACK PIG WEED, BLADDER KETMIA, BOGGABRI WEED, CALTROP (YELLOW VINE), CAUSTIC WEED, COMMON SOW THISTLE, COMMON THORNAPPLE, COWVINE (PEACHVINE) FAT HEN, GREEN AMARANTH, MINTWEED, MOSSMAN RIVER GRASS, NOOGOORA BURR, PIGWEEED, PRICKLY PADDY MELON, RED ROOT AMARANTH, SLIM AMARANTH, SUMMER GRASS, WILD GOOSEBERRY).	750-1650 g ai/ha (1.5 to 3.3 L/ha of 500 g/L product or 0.85 - 1.85 kg/ha of a 900 g/kg product)

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply immediately post sowing onto bare moist soil or irrigate lightly within 3 days of spraying.
- Use lower rate if overhead irrigation. Some mechanical cultivation may be required.
- Do not use on azuki beans on light sandy soil.
- Severe injury may occur to azuki plants if heavy rainfall or large quantities of irrigation water is applied between application and crop emergence and this risk must be assumed by the user.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food for 9 weeks after application.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

For permit renewal, the permit holder is required to generate additional residue data from a minimum of 2 trials conducted on azuki beans in Australia, during the life of this permit, for submission to the APVMA. Contact the APVMA to ascertain the appropriate type and extent of residue data required to allow this permit to be reissued.
