This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CROP CARE BARRACK 720 FUNGICIDE

BRAVO WEATHER STIK FUNGICIDE

NUFARM UNITE 720 FUNGICIDE

NUFARM UNITE ULTRASTICK FUNGICIDE

BARRACK BETTERSTICK FUNGICIDE

Containing 720 g/L CHLOROTHALONIL as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
CHICKPEA	<i>Ascochyta</i> spp.	Apply 1.0-2.0 L/ha
FABA BEANS	<i>Botrytis</i> spp.	Apply 1.4-2.3 L/ha
LENTILS	<i>Ascochyta</i> spp. <i>Botrytis</i> spp.	Apply 1.0-2.0 L/ha

Critical Use Comments:

Apply at the first sign of disease on leaves, or if weather conditions favour the development of the disease. These conditions often occur 6 - 8 weeks after sowing.

Make repeat applications at 14 day intervals as necessary.

Use the higher rate if the crop is dense and disease pressure is high.

Best results are obtained using a boom spray applying a minimum of 100 L of water per ha.

DO NOT apply more than 4 applications to any crop.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT HARVEST FOR 7 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

DO NOT GRAZE OR FEED TREATED CROPS OR CROP RESIDUES TO LIVESTOCK.

ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, TAS, WA

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their 'control-of-use' legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in VIC)

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the permit particularly the information included in DETAILS OF PERMIT and CONDITIONS OF PERMIT.

EXPORT OF PRODUCE:

Exported produce or animals must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.
