**SPINNAKER 700 WDG HERBICIDE**

Containing: 700.00 g/kg IMAZETHAPYR as its only active constituent.

**Critical Use Comments:**

Apply to moist, well prepared, clod and weed free soil after planting and before crop emergence. Sufficient rainfall or irrigation is required after application and prior to weed emergence to wet soil to a depth of 5 cm. Good crop growth will aid weed control.

\* Surviving plants will generally be retarded and will not compete with the crop.

**Withholding Period:**

DO NOT APPLY LATER THAN 14 DAYS BEFORE HARVEST.

DO NOT GRAZE OR CUT FOR STOCK FOOD FOR 4 WEEKS AFTER APPLICATION
