



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

**FOR CONTROL OF ANNUAL GRASSES AND BROADLEAF WEEDS
IN BLUEBERRIES**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

Products to be used:

CASORON 4G HERBICIDE [APVMA No. 69139]

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 40 g/kg DICHLOBENIL as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop Type	Target Weeds	Application Rate
BLUEBERRIES	Annual grasses and broadleaf weeds	101-152 kg product / ha

Critical Use Comments:

- DO NOT apply more than two (2) applications per year.
- Apply using calibrated granular chemical applicator. DO NOT dispense via dust prone methods. Only use with applicators specifically designed to dispense granular products.
- Apply first application prior to budburst and second application following final harvest.
- Use higher rate for heavier weed infestations.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: DO NOT graze livestock on treated areas.

DO NOT use any part of treated crop for animal feed.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES, except VIC

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their *Control-of-Use* legislation does not require a permit to legalise this off-label use in this state.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.

Export of produce:

To allow treated produce to be supplied or otherwise made available for human consumption a temporary Maximum Residue Limit (TMRL) have been established for Dichlobenil in Blueberry at T1 mg/kg. This TMRL applies only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. If treated produce is to be exported, due account should be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries. Any residues must not exceed requirements of the importing country.
