MINIMISE THE RISK OF PHYLLOXERA.**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

ALL REGISTERED products containing GLYPHOSATE at a level of either 360, 450, 470, 480, 490, 495, 500, 510, 517, 535, 540, 570, 600 or 625 g/L as their only active constituent;

Directions for Use:

Crop	Purpose	Dose
GRAPEVINES	REMOVAL OF UNWANTED AND ABANDONED VINES TO MINIMISE THE RISK OF PHYLLOXERA	Vine diameter of 0-10cm Apply in a ratio of 1:15 (product to water). <hr/> Vine diameter of 0-30cm Apply in a ratio 1:1 (product to water).

Critical Use Comments:

- Dilute glyphosate product with water in the recommended ratio.
- Apply as a cut stump method. Cut vine close to the ground and immediately wet stump surface thoroughly using splatter gun, spray, swab or brush.
- Remove any canes on the stump and treat cut surface.
- Retreatment will be necessary to newly cut stumps for vines that escape the first treatment.

Jurisdiction:

QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.
