CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

All registered products containing between 763 g/L and 861 g/L petroleum oil as their only active constituent, including those described as paraffinic oil and mineral oil.

(NOTE: Products to be used include only those referred to as summer spray oils.)

Directions for Use:

Crop	Insect Pest	Rate
<i>Rubus</i> spp. <i>Ribes</i> spp.	Two Spotted Mite (<i>Tetranychus urticae</i>) Scale Insects	1 – 2 L product per 100L

Critical Use Comments:

Spray every 5 - 7 days or as required using airblast type sprayer.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT HARVEST FOR 1 DAY AFTER APPLICATION.

Jurisdiction:

All States (except Victoria)

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because of their 'control-of-use' legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in VIC.)

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

TO AVOID CROP DAMAGE:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.
